Principles of Project Management and Analytics: The Keys to Efficiently Managing Construction Disputes

Abstract

Resolving construction disputes can be a very lengthy and expensive proposition, and the risks that a claimant faces during the dispute resolution process are significant. Managing the resolution of a construction dispute is similar to managing a construction project. The management process needs to be implemented at the outset, requires good scope definition, a proper plan, a budget, and an adequate control system. The process may also require an important amount of data analysis, for which the use of construction analytics can be beneficial. This presentation will focus on the application of selected principles of project management to the dispute resolution process in the construction industry, and how embedding construction analytics can improve the process.
