INTRODUCTION

AACE International and AACE Montreal Section are dedicated to advancing the study of cost engineering and/or cost management disciplines. Primary fields include: cost engineering, project controls, estimating, planning and scheduling and project management. To promote this objective, AACE is awarding academic scholarships to full-time students pursuing a related degree (engineering, construction management, quantity surveying and related disciplines) whose studies include learning the effective application of professional and technical expertise to plan and control resources, costs, profitability and risk.

ELIGIBILITY

Student must be currently enrolled in a full-time undergraduate (second year or higher) or graduate program and graduating students must have been accepted to attend a full-time graduate program in the next academic year. Students must be enrolled in a program related to total cost management (engineering, construction management, quantity surveying, etc.).

EVALUATION CRITERIA

Scholarship students are selected based on the scholarship application, which demonstrates the student's academic performance (35% – official transcript required), extracurricular activities (35%) and which includes a one-page essay (30%) identifying why planning is a crucial element in project controls.

APPLICATIONS

Applications for AACE International must be in English and completed online at www.aacei.org no later than **February 28, 2018**. These applications are automatically entered into the Montreal Section competition.
